Products and Services

1. Sawing and sales of Japanese cypress

We produce pillars (including through pillars) and house foundations, both made of solid Japanese cypress. Our staple product in this field is our original brand "Takumi Kantaro", pillars made of dried Japanese cypress without any back split.

2. Production and sales of laminated wood

We make laminated wood by gluing Japanese cypress material, or by gluing lamina which is imported from Scandinavia and North America. Our staple product in this field is "Eco Earth Wood" made of legally cut Scotch pine from Scandinavia.

We mortise wood material, or cut a slot in wood to join securely, as with a mortise and tenon.

4. Sales of housing material

We sell housing wood material and such household equipment as sashes and integrated kitchen

We import laminae (material for laminated wood) from such Scandinavian countries as Finland and Sweden, and such North American countries as Canada. All imported wood has been of trees cut down legally, conforming to the requirements of the SGEC (Sustainable Green Ecosystem Council). As for our exports, we sell Japanese cypress boards to such Asian countries as China and Korea.
